Document	Description	Included
Online Application	Complete the application form on the Highways England Innovation Portal	
Health & Safety Assessment	Your assessment of the health & safety impact and risks of your solution.	
Company History	A description and history of your company and any associated companies, including safety and quality systems, environmental approvals.	
Product Description	Details of the road marking material you propose along with the manufacturers name and address with composition breakdown including, but not limited to, where applicable resin %, TiO2 %, intermix glass beads %.	
Application Method Statement	Detailed method statement for application including, but not limited to, where applicable, temperature, dosage rates, thickness, drop on beads type & quantity, mixing time and climatic conditions	
Customer Impact Statement	Assessment of the customer impact of the application method, for example time to apply, time to dry, time for the road to be available to traffic, any odour at application and subsequently.	
Declaration of Performance	Details of expected road marking performance as compared to our stated minimum required criteria.	
Removal Method Statement	Your detailed method statement for the removal of the material at the end of the test period. To include labour plant and materials, climatic conditions and expected road surface impact	
Declaration of Sustainability	Assessment of the environmental impact of the product, including chemical, glass or plastic content and handling, recyclability, packaging disposal etc. for both application and removal. It will also include the labour, plant and materials resource required for the removal process
